All the good finger sandwiches, hors d'oeuvres, and a cake (of course!).

Games to Play:

Wedding Charades. Divide group into teams and have a basket filled with pieces of paper. On each paper will be written a wedding-related word, vow, song, etc... A person from one team draws a word/phrase and acts it out with a timer set for two minutes. If their team guesses correctly, they get a point. The team with the most points wins!

Cold Feet! This game is best played outside. All you need is a large bucket filled with icy water. Throw in plastic rings and bridal-themed trinkets. Guests take turns plunging their feet into the chilly water to fish out as many items as they can, using only their toes!

Guess the Candy Count! This is a traditional game played at many bridal showers. Fill a jar with candy (counting each piece). Ask each guest to guess how many pieces are inside, writing answers on paper. The person who comes closest to the correct number takes home the prize!

Guess the Chick Flick Game!

Type out quotes from favorite chick flick movies and see who can guess what movie they're from. Here are a few examples (the answers are below):
